Trinity College London Grade 5 Theory of Music Examination - Merit

2019

--Syllabus includes a wide range of key signatures (up to 5 sharps and flats), pentatonic major scales, accented passing and auxiliary notes, modulations, imperfect cadences, supertonic and subdominant triads; applying this knowledge to read and write bass and treble lines in alto and tenor clefs, identify the vocal and instrumental ranges, write and correct bars of music and engage in detailed analysis of a longer piece.

Trinity College London Grade 4 Theory of Music Examination - Distinction

2018

--Syllabus includes a range of key signatures (up to 3 sharps and flats) and compound time signatures. A general understanding of anacrusis, triplets, melodic minor scales, second inversions of tonic triads, chord progressions, and cadences is required. Composing treble and bass lines and four-part chords is also introduced.

Trinity College London Grade 3 Theory of Music Examination - Distinction

2017

--Syllabus includes a basic knowledge of key and time signatures on bass and treble clef and applying that knowledge to writing sequences as well as major, minor, and harmonic minor scales, arpeggios, first inversions of chords, and transposing tunes up and down an octave. A basic understanding of syncopation and musical analysis is also required.
